Mannion and local educators highlight \$1.1 billion in funding for schools and Pre-K programs," Local SYR.com, 04/14/2021</p> <p>Senator John Mannion visited the Park Hill School in the East Syracuse Minoa District (ESM) Wednesday afternoon, outlining the record \$1.1 billion in education funding for local schools, as well as the expansion of Pre-K and early childhood learning programs.</p> <p>...</p> <p>In Mannion's district, the 50th Senate District, the new budget provides an expansion of up to 10 new full-day Pre-K programs that would serve more than 800 students.</p> <p>It also provides the framework for fully-funded Foundation Aid within 3 years, something Mannion says is long overdue. Dr. Desiato explained that this is the aid that is used for a school district's overall instruction and programs.</p>

This legislation also creates a civil cause of action for unlawful interference with the protected rights to reproductive healthcare. • S9079A: Prohibits professional misconduct charges against licensed medical professionals for providing legal abortion and reproductive health services to patients who reside in states where such services are illegal. • S9079B: Prohibits professional misconduct charges against health care practitioners for providing reproductive health services to patients who reside in states where such services are illegal. • S9077: Provides certain legal protections for abortion service providers including protection from extradition, arrest and legal proceedings in other states relating to abortions legally performed in this state.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • S9080B: which prohibits medical malpractice insurers from taking adverse action against a healthcare provider in New York State for performing legal healthcare reproductive services, protecting providers, and ensuring that people can safely access abortion and related services in New York State. • S9384A: which expands the eligibility of the Address Confidentiality Program to include reproductive health care services providers, employees, volunteers, patients, or immediate family members of reproductive health care services providers. • S1066: provides legal protection for New York doctors to prescribe and send abortion pills to patients in states that have outlawed abortion. • S470: Authorizes the Commissioner of Health to conduct a study and issue a report examining the unmet health and resource needs facing pregnant women in New York and the impact of limited service pregnancy centers. <p>“Abortion protections in New York fortified ahead of SCOTUS ruling,” Anna Gronewold, Politico, 06/13/2022</p> <p>NEW YORK — New York is on its way to becoming a national abortion “safe haven” with a series of new laws aimed at shielding abortion patients and providers from out-of-state legal actions, Gov. Kathy Hochul said.</p> <p>Hochul on Monday signed a package of bills that she and state lawmakers rushed to approve in the final days of session this year ahead of a potential U.S. Supreme Court ruling that could overturn <i>Roe v. Wade</i>, making New York among the first in the nation to act ahead of the looming federal decision.</p>
